CHALLENGE DESCRIPTION

It offers seminars, certifications, academic courses, postgraduate master's courses, pre-college programs for international students as well as tailor-made in-house training for companies. In addition, the Technikum Wien Academy has had experience in handling retraining and qualification measures for the Austrian labor market since 2005.

The primary goal of the Technikum Wien Academy is to enable lifelong learning at the interface between technology and business and to counteract the shortage of skilled workers. insights and a focus on the participation of students in achieving learning success. The possible connection to the existing system landscape of the Technikum Wien Academy (ldap connections, FH Complete, Moodle, etc.) is essential for the usability of the teachers and learners. Furthermore, mobile applications and accessibility are of enormous advantage for our target group.

These sought-after solutions can be modular, meet parts of the requirement and / or be further developed together with the experts from the Technikum Academy. Solution parts, findings and adaptations of successful digital interaction methods from other areas of application and industries (e.g. employee engagement systems, quality assurance systems in production, social media and web shop interaction methods) can make a valuable contribution to an optimal overall solution.

- In any case, your startup should be founded
- The first Edu-Tech projects have already been successfully implemented
- Experience in technical and organizational implementation
- Strong communication skills with various stakeholders (university management, teaching and learning center, degree programs, lecturers, students, innovation department)
- Working language German or English
- Willingness to jointly further develop experimental or non-industry solution elements
- Willingness to work with other startup teams that bring complementary elements into an overall solution
- Willingness to work together in Vienna

Offer to the winning team:

The Technikum Wien Academy offers the winner

- Joint test use of the solution or tool (PoC)
- In the event of success: extended deployment and deeper cooperation up to a possible roll-out
- Participation in workshops at the Technikum Academy
- Use of the services of the Technikum start-up company partnership (job exchange, company fair, support in arranging bachelor theses / internships) during the project period to the value of EUR 1,500. ([Link Business Partners](#))

This platform is used to pre-select eligible participants, which are then presented to the buddy company. The most suitable three (up to a maximum of five) startups for the final (pitch day) are then selected by the Technikum Wien Academy with the involvement of the coaches; the finalists will be notified via email. In a final step, the ideas are finalized and presented. One or more winners can be chosen from the finalists. There is no legal entitlement to the conclusion of contracts or other business relationships between the participants / winners and the Technikum Wien Academy. There is also no legal right to a final and / or the determination of a winner. The participants do not receive any allowance for their participation.

The conditions of participation, parts of the process or the entire process can be changed at any time. The changes will be announced in good time and published on the platform www.inno-up.at.
