## CHALLENGE DESCRIPTION



*The Sozialversicherungs-Chipkarten Betriebs- und Errichtungsgesellschaft m.b.H. - SVC (social insurance chip card operating and establishment G.m.b.H. - SVC) develops and implements demanding IT projects in the field of Austrian social security. The e-card system, ELGA, e-medication and the social security internet portal are among these projects. Our task is to further develop Austria's healthcare system from a technological point of view and to keep it fit for the future. With the e-card system, we have created a basis that is the envy of many countries around the world. We want to build on that. Intelligent and practical services should make everyday life in healthcare easy and safe for everyone involved.*

### Category:

Via inno up, SVC GmbH is looking for innovative startups with solutions, services or technologies for optimal visualization and modern presentation of health data. In particular, it is about visualizing and graphically presenting aggregated data that has already been published - such as current hospital occupancy, various other statistical metrics, etc.

However, our considerations go beyond pure visualization: our goal is to develop the prototype of a "public dashboard" using these (partial) solutions.

## Eligibility criteria:

To take part in the SVC challenge, your startup should meet the following criteria:

- In any case, your startup should be founded
- Ideal status: proof of market – if not in the health sector, other sectors/industries are also interesting;
- Another possibility: proof of concept – if not in the health sector, other sectors/industries are also interesting;
- IP of your solution/your tool/your service is up to you
- Willingness to cooperate with the main association of social security and the SVC GmbH in Vienna
- Working language German or English

## Offer to the winning team:

SVC GmbH offers the winning team:

- Prize money in the amount of EUR 5.000.-
- Recognition amount of EUR 1.500.- for the second and third place winners
- Joint further development and possible adaptation to the needs and requirements of the main association and SVC GmbH (if possible and sensible)
- Purpose-specific provision of anonymized real data
- Joint PR and communication work in case of success

SVC GmbH defines a task (challenge) on the basis of which innovative start-ups register on an online platform via the project website [www.inno-up.at](http://www.inno-up.at). This platform is used to preselect eligible participants, which is then presented to the buddy company. After that, SVC GmbH selects the most suitable three (up to a maximum of five) startups for the final (pitch day) with the involvement of the coaches; the finalists will be informed via e-mail. In a final step, the ideas are finalized and presented. One or more winners can be chosen from the finalists. There is no legal entitlement to the conclusion of contracts or other business relationships between the participants/winners and SVC GmbH. Likewise, there is no legal entitlement to a final and/or the determination of a winner. The participants will not receive any compensation for their participation.
